# TOUCHING LIVES: IMPACT STORIES

"I sat with Ms. Adele for her hand massage. As I worked, she leaned back, closed her eyes, and said, 'You can do this forever."

"A woman at the nursing home said, 'But you can hold my hand, because when you hold my hand it feeds my soul."

"One of the elders we know has lost the ability to speak. She had turned down the opportunity for hand massage, but when she heard someone had asked for her by name, she obliged. As she sat with our volunteer hand in hand, enjoying the sensation of touch, she kept showing us the 'thumbs up' sign. And she was smiling."

"They had a new resident in memory care and the moment I started putting lotion on his hands he had the biggest prolonged smile! The staff said it was the biggest smile with laughter they had seen on him since moving into memory care."

In this class, you will learn:


the different types of touch and purpose of skilled touch in providing quality care



# WHAT'S MOST IMPORTANT: ::::::

"Most days in recent weeks, Ms. Norma is in bed. If she's awake, and you talk to her, she will move her head very slowly in your direction, but her stare is vacant. There is a pause between what you ask her and her reply. Sometimes she is not able to reply. This Wednesday, I sat by her bed in her room. I said a few things to her, and after a little while she stopped answering. But in the silence, she slid both of her hands over to me. I massaged her hands like I have been doing every week for months — now we just do it a little bit differently."
